PRODUCT USE

Right Start™ UDL is a roofing membrane designed for use as a water-resistant underlayment and dry-in sheet for steep slope roofing applications to include asphalt shingles, roof tile, and wood shakes and shingles. It is fortified with sustainable NEX® polymer modified asphalt, technology that utilizes polymers from repurposed materials to refine the physical characteristics necessary for peak product performance and longer service life. Right Start™ UDL is approved for use under fire-rated, code-compliant roof coverings; please consult Malarkey's Technical Services Department for approval of roof systems.

COMPOSITION & MATERIALS

Right Start™ UDL is manufactured on a non-woven fiberglass mat, impregnated and coated on both sides with NEX® polymer modified asphalt, and surfaced with a mineral release material.

APPLICATION

Right Start™ UDL shall be applied as specified. It is not intended as a permanently-exposed roofing surface but can be left uncovered for up to 90 days if necessary before the primary roof covering is installed. Installation instructions can be found on our website at WWW.MALARKEYROOFING.COM or by contacting our Technical Services Department.

PRECAUTION

Store Right Start™ UDL on end to prevent rolls from flattening. Malarkey recommends allowing Right Start™ UDL to warm up and relax prior to application in colder weather. Roof decks should be sound, smooth, and meet adopted building code requirements. Minimum approved slope is 2" (51 mm) per 12" (305 mm). For slopes 2:12 up to 4:12 (4" [102 mm] per 12" [305 mm]), a double layer of underlayment is required (IBC & IRC have an exception for a single layer of ASTM D1970 underlayment in lieu of a double layer). Certain roof tiles with minimal contact to the surface of Right Start™ UDL may be prone to sliding.

WARRANTY

Right Start™ UDL is eligible for expanded warranty coverages relative to its use as a single roofing *accessory* or in combination with others in a complete Malarkey Secure Choice™ roofing system. Installed separately, it carries a 10-year product warranty against manufacturing defects. Contact your roofing contractor, local distribution center, or Malarkey for full details.
